CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **St. Mary's County - Appointment to Assistant Sheriff - Rank Eligibility**

3 FOR the purpose of altering a certain provision so as to provide that, in St. Mary's
4 County, only a deputy sheriff who holds one of the two permanent ranks
5 immediately preceding the rank of Assistant Sheriff is eligible for appointment
6 to Assistant Sheriff; and generally relating to the appointment of the Assistant
7 Sheriff of St. Mary's County.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article 19 - St. Mary's County**

18 B. (3) Only a deputy sheriff who holds **ONE OF** the **TWO** permanent
19 [rank of Sergeant or Lieutenant] **RANKS IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE RANK OF**
