1 AN ACT concerning

2 **St. Mary's County – Adult Public Guardianship Review Board – Membership**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring one of two physician members of the Adult Public
4 Guardianship Review Board of St. Mary's County to be a psychiatrist or
5 psychologist from a local health department that employs psychiatrists or
6 psychologists; and generally relating to the Adult Public Guardianship Review
7 Board of St. Mary's County.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
9 Article – Family Law
10 Section 14–402(a)(2)
11 Annotated Code of Maryland
12 (2006 Replacement Volume and 2008 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Family Law**

16 14–402.

18 (i) 1 shall be a professional representative of a local

1 (ii) 2 shall be physicians, including:

2 1. 1 psychiatrist from a local health department that
3 employs psychiatrists; OR

4 2. IN ST. MARY'S COUNTY, 1 PSYCHIATRIST OR
5 PSYCHOLOGIST FROM A LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT THAT EMPLOYS
6 PSYCHIATRISTS OR PSYCHOLOGISTS;

7 (iii) 1 shall be a representative of a local commission on aging;

8 (iv) 1 shall be a professional representative of a local nonprofit
9 social service organization;

10 (v) 1 shall be a lawyer;

11 (vi) 2 shall be lay individuals;

12 (vii) 1 shall be a public health nurse;

13 (viii) 1 shall be a professional in the field of disabilities; and

14 (ix) 1 shall be a person with a physical disability.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 October 1, 2009.
