THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 15, SUBTITLES 4, 7, AND 8 OF THE

INSURANCE ARTICLE SHALL APPLY TO THE PROGRAM IN THE SAME MANNER.

1 THEY APPLY TO INSURERS, NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLANS, AND HEALTH

2 MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS.

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- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to the counties, the county school systems, and the State Employee and Retiree Health and Welfare Benefits Program at the time their health benefit plans are issued, delivered, or renewed in the State on or after January 1, 2010.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2009.
