A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Criminal Law – Manslaughter and Vehicular Manslaughter – Penalties**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the possible term of imprisonment for a conviction for the
4 crime of manslaughter or vehicular manslaughter; and generally relating to the
5 crimes of manslaughter and vehicular manslaughter.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Criminal Law**

19 2–207.

20 (a) A person who commits manslaughter is guilty of a felony and on
21 conviction is subject to:

22 (1) imprisonment not exceeding [10] **30** years; or

1 (2) imprisonment in a local correctional facility not exceeding 2 years
2 or a fine not exceeding \$500 or both.

3 2-209.

4 (a) In this section, "vehicle" includes a motor vehicle, streetcar, locomotive,
5 engine, and train.

6 (b) A person may not cause the death of another as a result of the person's
7 driving, operating, or controlling a vehicle or vessel in a grossly negligent manner.

8 (c) A violation of this section is manslaughter by vehicle or vessel.

9 (d) A person who violates this section is guilty of a felony and on conviction is
10 subject to imprisonment not exceeding [10] **30** years or a fine not exceeding \$5,000 or
11 both.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 October 1, 2009.
