- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 Article - State Government

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- 16 (a) There is an Education Trust Fund which is a special, nonlapsing fund that is not subject to § 7–302 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 18 (b) (1) There shall be credited to the Education Trust Fund all proceeds allocated to the Fund under § 9–1A–27 of this subtitle.
- 20 (2) Money in the Education Trust Fund shall be invested and reinvested by the Treasurer, and interest and earnings shall accrue to the Fund.
- 22 (c) Money in the Education Trust Fund shall be used to:

- 1 (1) provide funding for public elementary and secondary education, 2 through continuation of the funding and formulas established under the programs 3 commonly known as the Bridge to Excellence in Public Schools Act, first enacted by 4 Chapter 288 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2002, including the funding for 5 regional differences in the cost of education under § 5–202(f) of the Education Article;
