A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Moving Violation Points Accountability Act**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing that points assessed against an individual's driving
4 record are to be retained for a period of time that commences on the date of the
5 conviction of the violation for which the points are assessed; and generally
6 relating to the accumulation of points against a driving record.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Transportation**

15 16–407.

16 A point assessed under this subtitle shall be retained for a period of 2 years
17 from the date of [violation] **CONVICTION**.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 October 1, 2009.
