## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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## Public Safety - Potomac River Bridges Security Zone Pilot Program

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Potomac River Bridges Security Zone Pilot Program in the Department of State Police; providing that the purpose of the 4 5 Program is to provide a certain security zone in the water surrounding certain bridges on the Potomac River; requiring the Department to contract with a 6 7 private security firm to patrol a certain security zone surrounding certain bridges; requiring a private security firm under the Program to patrol a certain 8 9 security zone in a certain manner and perform certain functions; providing for 10 Program funds; requiring the Secretary of State Police to submit a certain report concerning the Program annually to the General Assembly on or before a 11 certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; defining a certain term; 12 13 and generally relating to the Potomac River Bridges Security Zone Pilot Program. 14

- 25 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 26 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:



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## Article - Public Safety

- 3 (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 4 (e) "Department" means the Department of State Police.
- 5 (l) "Secretary" means the Secretary of State Police.

- 7 (a) (1) The Department has the general duty to safeguard the lives and 8 safety of all persons in the State, to protect property, and to assist in securing to all
- 9 persons the equal protection of the laws.

- 11 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "PROGRAM" MEANS THE POTOMAC RIVER
- 12 Bridges Security Zone Pilot Program.
- 13 (B) THERE IS A POTOMAC RIVER BRIDGES SECURITY ZONE PILOT
- 14 PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT.
- 15 (C) (1) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE A 500-FOOT
- 16 SECURITY ZONE IN THE WATER SURROUNDING THE WOODROW WILSON
- 17 MEMORIAL BRIDGE AND THE HARRY W. NICE MEMORIAL POTOMAC RIVER
- 18 **BRIDGE.**
- 19 (2) (I) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONTRACT WITH A PRIVATE
- 20 SECURITY FIRM TO PATROL THE SECURITY ZONE SURROUNDING EACH BRIDGE.
- 21 (II) THE PRIVATE SECURITY FIRM SHALL PATROL THE
- 22 SECURITY ZONE IN ONE OR MORE VESSELS PILOTED BY RETIRED MILITARY
- 23 PERSONNEL AND MANNED BY RETIRED POLICE OFFICERS.
- 24 (III) THE PRIVATE SECURITY FIRM PERSONNEL
- 25 CONDUCTING THE PATROLS OF THE SECURITY ZONE SHALL:
- 26 1. MONITOR THE SECURITY ZONE FOR POTENTIAL
- 27 THREATS TO PUBLIC SAFETY; AND
- 28 2. PROVIDE ASSISTANCE TO RECREATIONAL
- 29 BOATERS IN DISTRESS AS NEEDED.

- 1 (D) FUNDS FOR THE PROGRAM SHALL BE AS PROVIDED BY THE 2 GOVERNOR IN THE STATE BUDGET.
- 3 (E) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE SECRETARY
  4 SHALL REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1246
  5 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, ON THE STATUS OF, AND THE BENEFITS
  6 ACCRUED FROM, THE POTOMAC RIVER BRIDGES SECURITY ZONE PILOT
  7 PROGRAM.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2009. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of September 30, 2012, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
