4 FOR the purpose of extending the expiration date of the conditional prohibition against the Comptroller on the issuance of a certificate of registration to a retail 5 6 service station dealer who markets motor fuel through a retail service station 7 that has been altered, enlarged, or structurally modified; altering the date after 8 which a producer, refiner, or wholesaler of motor fuel is required to extend 9 voluntary allowances uniformly to all retail service station dealers that are 10 supplied by the producer, refiner, or wholesaler; and generally relating to 11 certificates of registration for retail service station dealers and the sale of

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Business Regulation

21 10–304.

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- 22 (a) The Comptroller may not issue a certificate of registration to a retail service station dealer who markets motor fuel through a retail service station altered,
- enlarged, or structurally modified after July 1, 1977, and before October 1, [2009]
- 25 **2014**, unless:

- 1 **(1)** the station contains an enclosed work area where the service of $\mathbf{2}$ motor vehicles is offered to customers regardless of whether motor fuel is bought; and 3 (2)the services offered include a battery charge, lubrication, oil 4 change, tire repair, and replacement of accessories such as fan belts, radiator hoses, or wiper blades. 5 6 Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section, the Comptroller may issue (b) 7 a certificate of registration to a retail service station dealer who markets motor fuel 8 through: 9 a retail service station that, before it is altered, enlarged, or **(1)** 10 structurally modified, lacks an enclosed work area; or 11 a retail service station that is altered, enlarged, or structurally (2)12 modified if the owner and retail service station dealer agree to the elimination of an 13 enclosed work area. 14 10 - 312.15 Each producer, refiner, or wholesaler of motor fuel who supplies motor fuel to 16 retail service station dealers: after September 30, [2009] 2014, shall extend all voluntary 17 **(1)** allowances uniformly to all retail service station dealers supplied; 18 19 (2)shall apply all equipment rentals uniformly to all retail service 20 station dealers supplied; and during periods of shortage: 21 (3)22 (i) shall apportion uniformly and equitably all gasoline and special fuel to all retail service station dealers supplied; and 2324 may not discriminate among retail service station dealers (ii) 25 supplied in their allotments.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2009.
