- 10 (D) THIS SECTION DOES NOT RELIEVE ANY POULTRY FACILITY FROM
 11 ANY REQUIREMENT UNDER THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY PLANNING AND
 12 COMMUNITY RIGHT-TO-KNOW ACT, OR UNDER ANY LOCAL ORDINANCE TO
