2 Crimes - Prohibition of Sale of Kits, Pipes, Cigarette Rolling Papers, and Cigar Leaf Wrappers - County Ordinances

- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the legislative body of a county to adopt an ordinance that prohibits a person from selling, subject to an exception, cocaine freebase 5 kits, glass or ceramic tubes of a certain size that are sold with or without a 6 7 screen-like device, cigarette rolling papers, and cigar leaf wrappers; providing 8 that a commercial wholesale or retail establishment may sell cigarette rolling 9 papers and cigar leaf wrappers under certain circumstances; authorizing a 10 county to impose certain criminal and civil penalties; and generally relating to 11 drug paraphernalia.
