12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Environment

15 **9–227.1**.

16 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "MOTOR VEHICLE OIL FILTER" MEANS A FILTER
 17 THAT REMOVES IMPURITIES FROM THE OIL USED TO LUBRICATE AN INTERNAL
 18 COMBUSTION ENGINE IN A MOTOR VEHICLE.

19(B) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, A20PERSON MAY NOT KNOWINGLY DISPOSE OF A MOTOR VEHICLE OIL FILTER IN A21LANDFILL.

22(c) The Department may waive the prohibition described in23SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IF A PERSON DEMONSTRATES TO THE



SATISFACTION OF THE DEPARTMENT THAT THE PERSON WOULD OTHERWISE SUFFER UNDUE ECONOMIC HARDSHIP.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 4 October 1, 2010.
