3	DAY FOR WHICH THE FORECASTED HIGH TEMPERATURE IS 32 DEGREES
4	FAHRENHEIT OR BELOW.

- 5 (B) A PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY MAY NOT TERMINATE ELECTRIC SERVICE TO A RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMER BECAUSE OF NONPAYMENT:
- 7 (1) ON A DAY FOR WHICH THE FORECASTED HEAT INDEX IS 95 8 DEGREES FAHRENHEIT OR ABOVE; OR
- 9 (2) ON THE DAY IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING A DAY FOR WHICH THE 10 FORECASTED HEAT INDEX IS 95 DEGREES FAHRENHEIT OR ABOVE.
- 11 (C) THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 12 SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2009.
