#### 1 AN ACT concerning

### 2 Frederick County – County Commissioners – Retirement Benefits

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of County Commissioners of Frederick 4 County to establish that each member may receive certain retirement benefits 5 or to establish within the county retirement program certain criteria and 6 benefits applying only to County Commissioners under certain circumstances; 7 placing certain restrictions on a criterion or benefit established under this Act; 8 providing that this Act does not apply to the salaries or compensation of the 9 incumbent County Commissioners; and generally relating to the retirement benefits of the members of the Board of County Commissioners of Frederick 10 11 County.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the County Commissioners of Frederick County in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the County Commissioners of Frederick County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.
