- 4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from owning, possessing, controlling, or otherwise having custody of more than a certain number of breeding dogs at any 5 6 time; establishing enclosure size and exercise requirements to be met by a 7 person owning, possessing, controlling, or otherwise having custody of more than a certain number of breeding dogs; establishing a penalty for a violation of 8 9 this Act; exempting certain facilities from the requirements of this Act; defining 10 certain terms; and generally relating to limitations on the possession of breeding dogs. 11
