## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Historic Commission – Appeals**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing certain persons to appeal certain decisions of a  
4 historic district commission or historic preservation commission to the local  
5 governing body; and generally relating to appeals from a decision of a historic  
6 district commission or historic preservation commission.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
8 Article 66B – Land Use  
9 Section 8.15  
10 Annotated Code of Maryland  
11 (2003 Replacement Volume and 2008 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 66B – Land Use**

15 8.15.

16 Any person aggrieved by a decision of a historic district commission or historic  
17 preservation commission may appeal the decision:

18 **(1) TO THE LOCAL GOVERNING BODY; OR**

19 **(2) [in] IN** the manner provided for an appeal from the decision of the  
20 zoning board or commission of the local jurisdiction.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
22 October 1, 2009.
