## A BILL ENTITLED

## 1 AN ACT concerning

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## Health Occupations – Licensure of Social Workers

FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Social Work Examiners to notify
applicants for licensure whether the applicants have been approved to take a
certain examination within a certain time period; altering certain requirements
for a waiver of examination requirements for certain applicants who are
licensed or registered to practice social work in other states; and generally
relating to the licensure of social workers.

14SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF15MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article – Health Occupations

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- 18 (a) To apply for a license, an applicant shall:
- 19 (1) Submit an application to the Board on the form that the Board 20 requires; and
- 21 (2) Pay to the Board the application fee set by the Board.

1 (1) Review each application; and  $\mathbf{2}$ (2)Notify each applicant whether the applicant has been approved to 3 take the pertinent licensure examination within [a reasonable time frame as defined in regulations] 30 DAYS AFTER THE DATE THE APPLICANT SUBMITTED AN 4 5 APPLICATION TO THE BOARD. 6 19 - 305.7 (a)Subject to the provisions of this section, the Board shall waive the examination requirements of this title for an applicant who is licensed or registered to 8 practice social work in any other state. 9 10 (b) [The] EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF 11 THIS SECTION, THE Board may grant a waiver under this section only if the 12applicant: Is of good moral character; 13 (1)14 (2)Pays the application fee required by the Board under § 19–303 of 15this subtitle; Provides adequate evidence that the applicant: 16 (3)17 (i) Meets the qualifications comparable to those required by this title; 18 19 (ii) Is currently licensed or registered in another state; 20 [Became] HAS BEEN licensed or registered AND IN GOOD (iii) 21**STANDING** in another state [under requirements substantially equivalent to the 22requirements of this title] FOR AT LEAST 2 YEARS BEFORE THE DATE THE 23APPLICANT SUBMITTED AN APPLICATION TO THE BOARD; and 24Became licensed or registered in the other state after (iv) 25passing in that or any other state an examination [that is the same as the 26examination for which the applicant is seeking the waiver] TO BE LICENSED OR 27**REGISTERED AS A SOCIAL WORKER**; and 28Did not previously receive a waiver of the examination (4)requirement from the Board. 29 30 SUBSECTION (B)(3)(IV) OF THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO AN **(C)** 

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31 APPLICANT WHO WAS LICENSED OR REGISTERED IN ANOTHER STATE BEFORE 32 JANUARY 1, 1991.
