#### **Health Occupations - Licensure of Social Workers**

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Social Work Examiners to notify applicants for licensure whether the applicants have been approved to take a 4 certain examination within a certain time period; altering certain requirements 5 6 for a waiver of examination requirements for certain applicants who are 7 licensed or registered to practice social work in other states requiring the Board 8 of Social Work Examiners to establish a workgroup consisting of a certain membership to examine certain issues affecting the status of the workforce and 9 submit a report to certain committees of the General Assembly on or before a 10 certain date; and generally relating to the licensure of social workers. 11

17	(3) on or before January 1, 2010, report its findings and				
18	recommendations, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, to the				
19	Senate Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee and the House				
20	Health and Government Operations Committee.
