3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Calvert County Board of License Commissioners 4 to issue a Class W winery license to certain holders of a Class 4 manufacturer's 5 license; specifying the privileges conferred by the Class W winery license, including the ability to sell wine and other products for consumption on or off 6 7 the premises and to maintain furnishings to enable patrons to consume wine 8 and food; specifying that a Class W winery license is a 7-day license exempt 9 from certain quotas; providing a license fee; specifying the hours of sale for a 10 Class W winery license; making a certain stylistic change; providing that a 11 holder of a certain license may exchange that license for a Class W winery license under certain circumstances; and generally relating to alcoholic 12 beverages in Calvert County. 13

- 25 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 26 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3	(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN CALVERT COUNTY.
4 5	(B) THE CALVERT COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE A CLASS W WINERY LICENSE TO A LICENSEE WHO:
6	(1) HOLDS A CLASS 4 MANUFACTURER'S LICENSE; AND
7 8 9	(2) HAS BEEN A RESIDENT OF THE STATE FOR AT LEAST 2 YEARS IMMEDIATELY BEFORE THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION FOR THE CLASS WINERY LICENSE.
10 11	(C) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE SHALL BE SET BY THE BOARD BUT MAY NOT EXCEED \$200.
12	(D) A CLASS W WINERY LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO:
13 14	(1) PROVIDE SAMPLES OF WINE AND OTHER PRODUCTS PRODUCED BY THE LICENSEE AT NO CHARGE;
15 16	(2) SELL WINE AND OTHER PRODUCTS PRODUCED BY THE LICENSEE FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR OFF THE PREMISES;
17 18	(3) HOLD PUBLIC AND PRIVATE EVENTS ON THE PREMISES IDENTIFIED IN THE LICENSE;

24	(E) A CLASS W WINERY LICENSE IS A 7-DAY LICENSE.

- 1 (G) A HOLDER OF A CLASS W WINERY LICENSE MAY LOCATE THE 2 OPERATION:
- 3 (1) On the premises for which the Class 4 4 manufacturer's license was issued;
- 5 (2) AT THE SAME ADDRESS AS ANOTHER CLASS W WINERY 6 LICENSE; OR
- 7 (3) AT ANOTHER LOCATION THAT THE BOARD APPROVES.

- 9 (A) [In] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IN
 10 Calvert County, licensees may sell alcoholic beverages authorized by their license

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a holder of Class 4 license who holds a who holds a Class A light wine license issued by the Calvert County Board of License Commissioners may surrender the Class A license to the Board and, in exchange, be issued a Class W winery license created by this Act at no charge. The expiration date of a Class W winery license issued under this section shall be the same as the expiration date of the surrendered Class A light wine license.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2009.
