## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County – Alcoholic Beverages – Class A/Class 4 Light Wine**  
3 **License**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing a Class A/Class 4 light wine license to be issued in  
5 Prince George's County; exempting a winery that applies for a certain license  
6 from certain quotas; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in  
7 Prince George's County.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages  
10 Section 4–201(a) and (c)  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (2005 Replacement Volume and 2008 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

16 4–201.

17 (a) A Class A light wine license may be issued only in:

18 (1) Anne Arundel County;

19 (2) Baltimore County;

20 (3) Calvert County;

21 (4) Caroline County;

18 (c) (1) A Class A light wine license may be issued by the license issuing  
19 authority of the county in which the place of business is located to any holder of a  
20 Class 4 manufacturer's license.

21 (2) A winery in Cecil County that applies for a Class A/Class 4 license  
22 is exempt from any quotas established by the Cecil County Board of License  
23 Commissioners as to the number of licenses in the election district where the winery is  
24 located.

25 (3) A winery in Baltimore County that applies for a Class A/Class 4  
26 license is exempt from any quotas established by the Baltimore County Board of  
27 License Commissioners as to the number of licenses in the election district where the  
28 winery is located.

1                   (4)    **A WINERY IN PRINCE GEORGE’S COUNTY THAT APPLIES FOR**  
2 **A CLASS A/CLASS 4 LICENSE IS EXEMPT FROM ANY QUOTAS ESTABLISHED BY**  
3 **THE PRINCE GEORGE’S COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS AS TO**  
4 **THE NUMBER OF LICENSES IN THE ELECTION DISTRICT WHERE THE WINERY IS**  
5 **LOCATED.**

6                   SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
7 July 1, 2009.
