BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Education Section 6-401(d) Annotated Code of Maryland (2008 Replacement Volume) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Education** 6-401.(d) "Public school employee" means a certificated professional (1) individual who is employed by a public school employer or an individual of equivalent status in Baltimore City, except for a county superintendent or an individual designated by the public school employer to act in a negotiating capacity as provided in § 6–408(b) of this subtitle.
