12	license under certain circumstances; and generally relating to alcoholic
13	beverages in Frederick County.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a holder of a Class 4 license who holds a Class A light wine license issued by the Frederick County Board of License Commissioners may surrender the Class A license to the Board and, in exchange, be issued a Class W winery license created by this Act at no charge. The

- expiration date of a Class W winery license issued under this section shall be the same as the expiration date of the surrendered Class A light wine license.
- 3 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 July 1, 2009.
