SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That: In accordance with § 19–102(d) of the Education Article, each of (1)the following projects is approved as a project for an academic facility, and the University System of Maryland may issue, sell, and deliver bonds in the total principal amount of \$10,000,000 for the purposes of financing and refinancing the costs of these projects: Bowie State University (Prince George's County) – Fine and (i) Performing Arts Building Towson University (Baltimore County) - College of Liberal (ii) Arts Complex
