 4 YOUNG HEROES HAVE MADE TO THE STATE, THE GOVERNOR SHALL PROCLAIM
 5 THE MONTH OF OCTOBER EACH YEAR AS YOUNG HEROES MONTH.
- 6 (B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL 7 ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE YOUNG HEROES MONTH PROPERLY WITH 8 APPROPRIATE PROGRAMS, CEREMONIES, AND ACTIVITIES.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2009.
