A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Allegany County – Alcoholic Beverages – Volunteer Company License

FOR the purpose of establishing a Class C (volunteer company) beer, wine and liquor
license in Allegany County; specifying the persons to whom the license may be
issued; specifying that a holder of the license may keep and sell alcoholic
beverages for consumption on or off the premises; specifying that the patrons of
a club for which a license is issued are not limited to certain individuals;
providing for a license fee; making certain stylistic changes; and generally
relating to alcoholic beverages in Allegany County.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 Article 2B Alcoholic Beverages
 - 18 6–301.
 - 19 (b) (1) (I) This subsection applies only in Allegany County.

20[(2)](II)The annual license fee FOR A CLASS C (GENERAL)21BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE is \$500.

22[(3)] (III)Beverages may be sold for consumption on the23premises or elsewhere.

1 (2) (I) THERE IS A CLASS C (VOLUNTEER COMPANY) BEER, 2 WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE.

3 (II) A VOLUNTEER COMPANY LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED TO A
 4 VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY, A VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE COMPANY, OR A
 5 COMBINED VOLUNTEER FIRE AND AMBULANCE COMPANY.

6 (III) A HOLDER OF A VOLUNTEER COMPANY LICENSE MAY 7 KEEP AND SELL ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR OFF 8 THE PREMISES.

9 (IV) PATRONS OF A CLUB FOR WHICH A VOLUNTEER 10 COMPANY LICENSE IS ISSUED ARE NOT LIMITED TO THE MEMBERS OF THE 11 LICENSE HOLDER AND THEIR GUESTS.

(V) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$500.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect14 June 1, 2009.
