 $\mathbf{2}$ The applicant shall be at least 18 years old. (c) 3 (**d**) The applicant shall have a doctoral degree in psychology AS DEFINED IN 4 § 18–101(C) OF THIS TITLE.  $\mathbf{5}$ Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, the applicant shall pass an (e) 6 examination given by the Board under this subtitle.  $\mathbf{7}$ (**f**) The applicant shall have at least 2 years of professional supervised 8 experience in psychology that is approved by the Board IN ACCORDANCE WITH 9 **REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD**. [At least 1 year of this required 10 experience shall have occurred after the doctoral degree is awarded.]

  resident of this State nor practicing in this State if the applicant shows that issuing
  the license would be in the interest of the citizens or government of this State.
