A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Calvert County - Sheriff - Pension

FOR the purpose of providing that the Board of County Commissioners for Calvert
County may make certain payments on or before a certain date equal to a
certain amount to certain individuals serving as the Sheriff of Calvert County
on or before a certain date who elected to participate in the Calvert County
Employees' Savings Plan on or after a certain date; providing for the
termination of this Act; and generally relating to pensions for sheriffs of Calvert
County.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11 MARYLAND, That:

12 (a) This section applies to an individual who:

13(1)on or before July 1, 2009, serves as the Sheriff of Calvert County;14and

15 (2) on or after July 1, 2008, elected to participate in the Calvert
16 County Employees' Savings Plan.

17 (b) On or before June 30, 2010, the Board of County Commissioners for 18 Calvert County may pay an individual described in subsection (a) of this section an 19 amount equal to the amount of contributions the Board of County Commissioners 20 would have made to the Calvert County Employees' Savings Plan on behalf of the 21 individual for the years of service the individual accrued as Sheriff of Calvert County 22 prior to joining the Calvert County Employees' Savings Plan.

(c) The amount payable in subsection (b) of this section may be made in one
 or more payments as deemed appropriate by the Board of County Commissioners for
 Calvert County.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 July 1, 2009. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of June 30, 3 2010, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be 4 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
