- FOR the purpose of requiring certain constituent institutions of the University System
 of Maryland designated for growth to submit a Community Impact Statement to
 the General Assembly under certain circumstances and at a certain time and to
 post the Community Impact Statement in a certain location; requiring the
 Community Impact Statement to include certain information; defining a certain
 term; and generally relating to Community Impact Statements submitted by
 designated growth institutions in the University System of Maryland.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Education

(A) IN THIS SECTION, "DESIGNATED GROWTH INSTITUTION" MEANS A
 CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION OF THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OF MARYLAND
 TARGETED FOR ENROLLMENT GROWTH FUNDING UNDER THE ENROLLMENT
 FUNDING INITIATIVE AND THAT HAS A STUDENT POPULATION OF 14,000 OR
 MORE.

1 (B) (1) A DESIGNATED GROWTH INSTITUTION SHALL SUBMIT A 2 COMMUNITY IMPACT STATEMENT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY EACH YEAR 3 THAT THERE IS AN INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT 4 STUDENTS AT THE INSTITUTION AND AT ANY TIME THE INSTITUTION UPDATES 5 ITS MASTER PLAN.

- 6 (2) A DESIGNATED GROWTH INSTITUTION REQUIRED TO 7 PREPARE A COMMUNITY IMPACT STATEMENT SHALL:
- 8 (I) SUBMIT THE COMMUNITY IMPACT STATEMENT TO THE 9 GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT THE SAME TIME AS THE INSTITUTION'S REQUEST FOR A 10 BUDGET APPROPRIATION; AND
- 11(II) POST THE COMMUNITY IMPACT STATEMENT12PROMINENTLY ON THE INSTITUTION'S WEBSITE.

13 (C) A COMMUNITY IMPACT STATEMENT SHALL DESCRIBE THE
 14 EXPECTED IMPACTS OF AND THE PROPOSED MEANS OF MITIGATING EXPECTED
 15 IMPACTS ON THE GROWTH OF THE DESIGNATED GROWTH INSTITUTION DURING
 16 THE FOLLOWING ACADEMIC YEAR ON THE FOLLOWING AREAS:

17(1) ROADS AND TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS OF THE COMMUNITY18EXTERNAL TO AND ADJACENT TO THE INSTITUTION'S CAMPUS;

- 19 (2) HOUSING OF INCOMING STUDENTS;
- 20 (3) SURROUNDING COMMUNITY NEIGHBORHOODS;

(4) THE INSTITUTION'S SYSTEM OF MONITORING AND TRACKING
 OF, AND APPLYING APPROPRIATE DISCIPLINE TO, STUDENTS LIVING
 OFF-CAMPUS WITHIN A 10-MILE RADIUS OF THE CAMPUS;

- (5) **INVESTMENT IN THE LOCAL COMMUNITY;**
- 25(6) LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICES, INCLUDING POLICE,26TRANSPORTATION, AND CODE ENFORCEMENT; AND
- 27 (7) EXCEPT FOR FACULTY, INSTITUTION PERSONNEL NECESSARY
 28 TO MEET THE NEEDS OF THE INSTITUTION'S GROWTH.

29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 30 July 1, 2009.
