- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 A PERSON MAY SELL NONPOTENTIALLY HAZARDOUS BAKED GOODS MADE
- 17 IN A KITCHEN IN A PRIVATE HOME WITHOUT A LICENSE TO OPERATE A FOOD
- 18 ESTABLISHMENT, IF THE BAKED GOODS ARE:
- 19 (1) SOLD TO AN INDIVIDUAL FOR THE INDIVIDUAL'S OWN
- 20 CONSUMPTION AND NOT FOR RESALE; AND
- 21 (2) CLEARLY LABELED "NOT FOR RESALE" AND "PROCESSED
- 22 AND PREPARED WITHOUT GOVERNMENT INSPECTION".

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2009.
