A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Income Tax – Military Retirement Income**

3 FOR the purpose of altering a subtraction modification under the State income tax for
4 certain military retirement income; providing for the application of this Act;
5 providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to the State income
6 tax of certain retirement income.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Tax – General**

2 (a) To the extent included in federal adjusted gross income, the amounts
3 under this section are subtracted from the federal adjusted gross income of a resident
4 to determine Maryland adjusted gross income.

5 (q) (1) (i) In this subsection the following words have the meanings
6 indicated.

7 (ii) "Military service" means:

8 1. induction into the armed forces of the United States
9 for training and service under the Selective Training and Service Act of 1940 or a
10 subsequent act of a similar nature;

11 2. membership in a reserve component of the armed
12 forces of the United States;

13 3. membership in an active component of the armed
14 forces of the United States;

15 4. membership in the Maryland National Guard; or

16 5. active duty with the commissioned corps of the Public
17 Health Service, the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, or the Coast
18 and Geodetic Survey.

19 (iii) "Military retirement income" means retirement income
20 received as a result of military service.

21 (2) The subtraction under subsection (a) of this section includes the
22 first [\$5,000] **\$10,000** of military retirement income received by an individual during
23 the taxable year.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
25 July 1, 2011, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after December 31,
26 2010.
