## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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## Natural Resources - Land Available for Tree Planting - Database

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources to establish a 4 database of certain land that is available and appropriate for certain tree 5 planting; requiring the Department to make the database available to the 6 general public free of charge; requiring the database to classify certain land in a 7 certain manner and identify sensitive areas on certain lands; requiring the 8 Department to establish a certain tree planting program for land recorded in 9 the database that gives priority to planting in sensitive areas; requiring the 10 Department to record certain land in the database and to solicit certain other 11 persons to record land in the database; requiring the Department to plant trees 12 on land recorded in the database to a certain extent and to solicit certain other 13 persons to fund, support, or implement tree planting projects on land recorded 14 in the database; authorizing the Department to adopt regulations to implement 15 this Act; and generally relating to a database of land available for tree planting 16 in the State.
