(A) IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, EXCEPT ON A VALID PRESCRIPTION OF
AN AUTHORIZED PRESCRIBER AS DEFINED IN § 12–101 OF THE HEALTH
OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE, A PERSON MAY NOT KNOWINGLY SELL OR OFFER FOR
SALE TO A MINOR A PRODUCT THAT IS LABELED AND MARKETED AS A SEXUAL
STIMULANT PILL.

1 (B) EACH RETAILER IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY THAT SELLS OR OFFERS 2 FOR SALE PRODUCTS THAT ARE LABELED AND MARKETED AS SEXUAL 3 STIMULANT PILLS SHALL DISPLAY AND STORE THE PRODUCTS SO THAT THE 4 PRODUCTS ARE ACCESSIBLE ONLY TO THE RETAILER OR AGENT OR EMPLOYEE 5 OF THE RETAILER AND ARE OUT OF REACH OF MINORS.

(C) THE SECRETARY SHALL:

7 (1) DEFINE PRODUCTS THAT ARE COVERED BY THE PROHIBITION
8 UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION; AND

9 (2) ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION.

10 (D) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL 11 PENALTY OF:

12 (1) \$300 FOR A FIRST VIOLATION; AND

13(2)\$500 FOR A SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION WITHIN A 24-MONTH14PERIOD AFTER THE PREVIOUS VIOLATION.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect16 October 1, 2009.
