## A BILL ENTITLED

**Health Care Facilities - Certificates of Need - Hospitals** 

1	AN ACT concerning	

- FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Health Care Commission to docket and review a certain application for a certificate of need based on a certain letter of intent notwithstanding the pendency of a certain application; requiring the Commission to review a certain application for a certificate of need in a certain manner; defining certain terms; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to certificates of need for hospitals.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Health General
- 17 19–120.
- 18 (f) **(1)** Except as provided in subsection (g)(2)(iii) of this section, a certificate of need is required before a new health care facility is built, developed, or established.

- 3. "GENERAL HOSPITAL" MEANS A HOSPITAL THAT
  IS CLASSIFIED AS A GENERAL HOSPITAL UNDER § 19–307(A)(1) OF THIS
  ARTICLE.
- 4. "ORIGINAL APPLICATION" MEANS AN
  APPLICATION DOCKETED ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 2009, FOR A CERTIFICATE
  OF NEED FOR THE BUILDING, ESTABLISHMENT, OR DEVELOPMENT OF AN
  ADDITIONAL GENERAL HOSPITAL AS A NEW HEALTH CARE FACILITY IN A
  JURISDICTION.
- (II) IF, PRIOR TO THE COMMISSION'S REVIEW AND DECISION ON AN ORIGINAL APPLICATION, AN ADDITIONAL LETTER OF INTENT IS FILED WITH THE COMMISSION ON THE FIRST AVAILABLE DATE AFTER THE FILING OF THE ORIGINAL APPLICATION ACCORDING TO THE SCHEDULE PUBLISHED BY THE COMMISSION, THE COMMISSION SHALL DOCKET AND REVIEW AN APPLICATION BASED ON THE ADDITIONAL LETTER OF INTENT NOTWITHSTANDING THE PENDENCY OF THE ORIGINAL APPLICATION.
- 21 (III) THE COMMISSION SHALL REVIEW AN APPLICATION 22 BASED ON AN ADDITIONAL LETTER OF INTENT RECEIVED UNDER 23 SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH COMPARATIVELY IN THE SAME 24 REVIEW OF THE ORIGINAL APPLICATION.
  - SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three–fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
