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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Income Tax Refund – Direct Deposit – Multiple Accounts**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Comptroller, if a certain request is made, to directly  
4 deposit an income tax refund into multiple accounts; and generally relating to  
5 the direct deposit of an income tax refund.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Tax – General**

14 13–905.

15 **(F) IF REQUESTED BY A CLAIMANT ON A FORM PROVIDED BY THE**  
16 **COMPTROLLER, THE COMPTROLLER SHALL DIRECTLY DEPOSIT PORTIONS OF**  
17 **AN INCOME TAX REFUND INTO AT LEAST TWO ACCOUNTS AT ONE OR MORE**  
18 **FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS, BEGINNING IN TAX YEAR 2010.**

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
20 October 1, 2009.
