## Frederick County - 10th Election District - Alcoholic Beverages Licenses Fundraising Events for Nonprofit Organizations

FOR the purpose of authorizing a nonprofit organization in the 10th election district in Frederick County to obtain a one-day special beer and wine license for use at a fundraising event for the organization; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Frederick County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
