### 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(s) "Neglect" means the leaving of a child unattended or other failure to give
proper care and attention to a child, INCLUDING FAILURE TO COMPLY AND
FOLLOW UP WITH THE REFERRAL RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE MARYLAND
STUDENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM ESTABLISHED BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT
OF EDUCATION, by any parent or other person who has permanent or temporary care
or custody or responsibility for supervision of the child under circumstances that
indicate:

24 (1) that the child's health or welfare is harmed or placed at 25 substantial risk of harm; or
