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# Higher Education - Community Colleges - BRAC - Exemption from Out-of-State and Out-of-County Fees

- 4 FOR the purpose of exempting certain employees and their family members as part of the Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) process from paying a certain 5 6 out-of-state or out-of-county fee at community colleges in the State; 7 authorizing each board of community college trustees to waive a certain 8 out-of-state fee and out-of-county or out-of-region fee for certain students; 9 requiring that certain students be included as in-State residents for a certain 10 computation of State aid; authorizing the Board of Trustees of Baltimore City Community College to waive a certain out-of-state fee for certain students; 11 defining a certain term; and generally relating to an exemption from the 12 out-of-state and out-of-county fees for BRAC employees and their family 13 members. 14

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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- 5 Subject to paragraphs (2), (3), (4), [and] (5), AND (6) of this (a) 6 subsection and subsection (f) of this section, any student who attends a community 7 college in this State and is not a resident of this State shall pay, in addition to the 8 student tuition and fees payable by a county resident, an out-of-state fee, at least 9 equal to:
- 10 60% of the county share per full-time equivalent student as (i) determined under § 16-305 of this subtitle; and 11
- 12 (ii) The marginal cost component of the State share per 13 full-time equivalent student as determined under § 16–305(c)(5) of this subtitle.
- 14 **(6)** IN THIS PARAGRAPH, "BRAC" MEANS THE BASE (I)15 REALIGNMENT AND CLOSURE PROCESS AS ANNOUNCED BY THE UNITED 16 STATES DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE.
- 17 (II)EACH BOARD OF COMMUNITY COLLEGE TRUSTEES MAY 18 WAIVE THE OUT-OF-STATE FEE AS DETERMINED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS 19 SUBSECTION FOR A STUDENT WHO RESIDES IN THE STATE BUT DOES NOT MEET 20 THE IN-STATE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR TUITION PURPOSES AND HAS 21MOVED TO THE STATE AS AN EMPLOYEE OR A FAMILY MEMBER OF AN 22 EMPLOYEE AS PART OF BRAC.
  - (III) ANY BRAC EMPLOYEE OR FAMILY MEMBER OF A BRAC EMPLOYEE ATTENDING A COMMUNITY COLLEGE IN THE STATE WHO SATISFIES THE REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED IN THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE INCLUDED AS AN IN-STATE RESIDENT FOR COMPUTATION OF THE STATE AID TO COMMUNITY COLLEGES IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 16–305 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- 28Subject to the provisions of paragraphs (2) [and], (3), AND (4) of (b) **(1)** 29 this subsection and subsection (g) of this section, any student who attends a community college not supported by the county in which the student resides shall pay, 30 31 in addition to the student tuition and fees payable by a resident of a county that 32supports the community college, an out-of-county or out-of-region fee at least equal 33 to 60% of the county share per full-time equivalent student as determined under § 16–305 of this subtitle.
