relating to the funding of certain student financial assistance programs.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## **Article – Education**

17 18–107.

18 (a) (1) Each year, money for each award program under this title shall be19 included in the State budget.

20 (2) Each year, the Governor shall include in the State budget at least 21 80 percent of the funds appropriated in the prior fiscal year for need-based programs 22 as provided in §§ 18–301, 18–706(f), 18–1401, 18–1501, and 18–2601 of this title and § 23 13–613(d)(1) of the Transportation Article.

1 (b) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this title, money appropriated 2 under this title that is not used by the end of the fiscal year may not revert to the 3 State Treasury.

4 (2) All money retained under paragraph (1) of this subsection shall be 5 used to make awards to students during subsequent fiscal years as provided in §§ 6 18–301, **18–601, 18–604,** 18–706(f), 18–1401, 18–14A–01, and 18–1501 of this title 7 and § 13–613(d)(1) of the Transportation Article and may not be used for 8 administrative expenses.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 July 1, 2009.
