It shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and 4 months and, 4 at the end of September 30, 2014, with no further action required by the General $\mathbf{5}$ Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of further force and effect. However, if a 6 7 monument to honor Maryland women in military service is completed and erected before September 30, 2014, the Commission on the Establishment of a Maryland 8 Women in Military Service Monument no longer needs to continue meeting after that 9 10 occurrence.
