## **Education Funding - Transfer of Funds from Land Preservation Programs**

- FOR the purpose of transferring certain funds in the State budget from certain land preservation programs to the General State School Fund under certain circumstances; requiring that funds transferred under this Act shall be used only for certain purposes; and generally relating to transferring funds from land preservation programs to the General State School Fund.
- 8 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 9 MARYLAND, That notwithstanding any other provision of law:
- 10 (a) Moneys appropriated in the State budget for the General Fund and special funds may not be expended for the purposes specified in:
- 12 (1) Title 2, Subtitle 5 of the Agriculture Article (Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation);
- 14 (2) Title 5, Subtitle 9 of the Natural Resources Article (Program Open 15 Space); and
- 16 (3) Title 5, Subtitle 9A of the Natural Resources Article (Rural Legacy 17 Program).
- 18 (b) Moneys appropriated in the Governor's proposed State budget for programs described in subsection (a) of this section shall be transferred to the General State School Fund and may be expended for the purposes specified in § 5–201 of the Education Article, except for school building construction aid.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply in any fiscal year in which the funding formulas and education programs described in

- 1 Title 5, Subtitle 2 of the Education Article are not fully funded in the State budget as
- 2 proposed by the Governor.
- 3 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 4 July 1, 2009.
