5 FOR the purpose of providing that certain elected members of the Prince George's
6 County Board of Education ~~are entitled to~~ may be provided certain health
7 insurance and other fringe benefits provided to certain employees of the Board
8 of Education; prohibiting the Prince George's County Board of Education from
9 expending any funds for certain purposes; providing for the application of this
10 Act; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to ~~benefits~~
11 ~~for elected members~~ expenditures of the Prince George's County Board of
12 Education.

5 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 6 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

7 **Article – Education**

8 3–1003.

9 (a) (1) From and after December 4, 2006, at the beginning of each
 10 member’s full term, the chair of the County Board is entitled to receive \$19,000
 11 annually as compensation and the other elected members are each entitled to receive
 12 \$18,000 annually as compensation.

13 (2) **EACH ELECTED MEMBER OF THE COUNTY BOARD IS**
 14 **~~ENTITLED TO~~ MAY BE PROVIDED HEALTH INSURANCE AND OTHER FRINGE**
 15 **BENEFITS REGULARLY PROVIDED TO EMPLOYEES OF THE BOARD OF**
 16 **EDUCATION UNDER THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS EXTENDED TO OTHER**
 17 **EMPLOYEES OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION.**

18 (b) (1) After submitting vouchers under the rules and regulations adopted
 19 by the County Board, the chair and the other members, including the student member,
 20 are entitled to the allowances for travel and other expenses provided in the Prince
 21 George’s County budget.

22 (2) A member of the County Board may not be reimbursed more than
 23 \$7,000 in travel and other expenses incurred in a single fiscal year.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding any
 25 other provision of law, the Prince George’s County Board of Education may not expend
 26 any funds for the purpose of leasing, acquiring, or purchasing property under or in
 27 connection with a lease entered into in June of 2008 for consolidation of administrative
 28 offices of the Board.

29 SECTION ~~2~~ 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act
 30 shall be construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to
 31 have any effect on or application to any member of the Prince George’s County Board
 32 of Education elected before November, 2010.

33 ~~SECTION 2. 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take~~
 34 ~~effect July 1, 2009.~~

1 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
2 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has
3 been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected
4 to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it
5 is enacted.
