## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County - Board of Education - Elected Members Benefits**

3 **PG 407-09**

4 FOR the purpose of providing that certain elected members of the Prince George's  
5 County Board of Education are entitled to certain health insurance and other  
6 fringe benefits provided to certain employees of the Board of Education; and  
7 generally relating to benefits for elected members of the Prince George's County  
8 Board of Education.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
10 Article - Education  
11 Section 3-1003  
12 Annotated Code of Maryland  
13 (2006 Replacement Volume and 2008 Supplement)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article - Education**

17 3-1003.

18 (a) (1) From and after December 4, 2006, at the beginning of each  
19 member's full term, the chair of the County Board is entitled to receive \$19,000  
20 annually as compensation and the other elected members are each entitled to receive  
21 \$18,000 annually as compensation.

22 (2) **EACH ELECTED MEMBER OF THE COUNTY BOARD IS**  
23 **ENTITLED TO HEALTH INSURANCE AND OTHER FRINGE BENEFITS REGULARLY**  
24 **PROVIDED TO EMPLOYEES OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION UNDER THE SAME**

1 **TERMS AND CONDITIONS EXTENDED TO OTHER EMPLOYEES OF THE BOARD OF**  
2 **EDUCATION.**

3 (b) (1) After submitting vouchers under the rules and regulations adopted  
4 by the County Board, the chair and the other members, including the student member,  
5 are entitled to the allowances for travel and other expenses provided in the Prince  
6 George's County budget.

7 (2) A member of the County Board may not be reimbursed more than  
8 \$7,000 in travel and other expenses incurred in a single fiscal year.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
10 July 1, 2009.
