5 FOR the purpose of providing that certain elected members of the Prince George's
6 County Board of Education ~~are entitled to~~ may be provided certain health
7 insurance and other fringe benefits provided to certain employees of the Board
8 of Education; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to
9 benefits for elected members of the Prince George's County Board of Education.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Education**

1 (a) (1) From and after December 4, 2006, at the beginning of each
 2 member's full term, the chair of the County Board is entitled to receive \$19,000
 3 annually as compensation and the other elected members are each entitled to receive
 4 \$18,000 annually as compensation.

5 (2) EACH ELECTED MEMBER OF THE COUNTY BOARD IS
 6 ~~ENTITLED TO~~ MAY BE PROVIDED HEALTH INSURANCE AND OTHER FRINGE
 7 BENEFITS REGULARLY PROVIDED TO EMPLOYEES OF THE BOARD OF
 8 EDUCATION UNDER THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS EXTENDED TO OTHER
 9 EMPLOYEES OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

10 (b) (1) After submitting vouchers under the rules and regulations adopted
 11 by the County Board, the chair and the other members, including the student member,
 12 are entitled to the allowances for travel and other expenses provided in the Prince
 13 George's County budget.

14 (2) A member of the County Board may not be reimbursed more than
 15 \$7,000 in travel and other expenses incurred in a single fiscal year.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
 17 construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have
 18 any effect on or application to any member of the Prince George's County Board of
 19 Education elected before November, 2010.

20 SECTION ~~2~~ 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
 21 effect July 1, 2009.
