FOR the purpose of authorizing the Prince George's County Board of License 4 $\mathbf{5}$ Commissioners to issue a wine festival license to certain persons for the sale of 6 wine at the Prince George's County Wine Festival each year; establishing 7 certain licensing requirements; requiring license holders to display and sell certain wine; providing for a license fee; requiring the Board to set the date and 8 9 location for the Festival and to assure that the primary focus of the Festival is 10 the promotion of Maryland wine; establishing certain requirements concerning the delivery and return of products displayed and sold at the Festival; requiring 11 12 the Board to adopt certain regulations; defining certain terms; and generally 13 relating to an alcoholic beverages license issued for the Prince George's County Wine Festival. 14
