- FOR the purpose of authorizing the Prince George's County Board of License 4 Commissioners to issue a wine festival license to certain persons for the sale of 5 6 wine at the Prince George's County Wine Festival; establishing certain licensing 7 requirements; requiring license holders to display and sell certain wine; 8 providing for a license fee; requiring the Board to set the date and location for the Festival and to assure that the primary focus of the Festival is the 9 promotion of Maryland wine; establishing certain requirements concerning the 10 delivery and return of products displayed and sold at the Festival; requiring the 11 12 Board to adopt certain regulations; defining certain terms; and generally relating to an alcoholic beverages license issued for the Prince George's County 13 14 Wine Festival.

4 (2) "BOARD" MEANS THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY BOARD OF 5 LICENSE COMMISSIONERS.

6 (3) "FESTIVAL" MEANS THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY WINE 7 FESTIVAL.

OF A WINE FESTIVAL LICENSE MAY DISPLAY AND SELL WINE AT THE FESTIVAL
FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR OFF THE PREMISES ON THE DAYS AND FOR THE
