4 5 6 7	(2) [A person who operates a business establishment for profit that is not licensed under this article may not knowingly allow customers to bring alcoholic beverages for consumption into the establishment] <b>AN OWNER OR OPERATOR OF A BOTTLE CLUB MAY NOT:</b>
8 9	(I) EVADE THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSE LAWS IN THE COUNTY, INCLUDING LAWS GOVERNING THE HOURS OF OPERATION; AND
10 11 12	(II) SELL, GIVE, SERVE, DISPENSE, KEEP, OR ALLOW TO BE CONSUMED IN THE BOTTLE CLUB ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE, SETUPS, OR OTHER COMPONENT PARTS OF MIXED ALCOHOLIC DRINKS.
13 14 15	(d) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 2 years or a fine not exceeding \$10,000 or both.
