A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Domestic Violence – Duration of Protective Order – Subsequent Act of Abuse**

3 FOR the purpose of extending the maximum duration of a final protective order under
4 certain circumstances; and generally relating to domestic violence and the
5 duration of a final protective order.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Family Law**

14 4–506.

15 (h) (1) Except as provided in [paragraph (2)] **PARAGRAPHS (2) AND (3)**
16 of this subsection, all relief granted in a final protective order shall be effective for the
17 period stated in the order, not to exceed [12 months] **1 YEAR.**

18 (2) **IF THE COURT ISSUES A FINAL PROTECTIVE ORDER UNDER**
19 **THIS SECTION AGAINST A RESPONDENT FOR AN ACT OF ABUSE COMMITTED**
20 **WITHIN 1 YEAR AFTER THE DATE THAT A PRIOR PROTECTIVE ORDER ISSUED**
21 **AGAINST THE SAME RESPONDENT EXPIRES, ALL RELIEF GRANTED IN THE FINAL**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **PROTECTIVE ORDER SHALL BE EFFECTIVE FOR THE PERIOD STATED IN THE**
2 **ORDER, NOT TO EXCEED 2 YEARS.**

3 **(3)** A subsequent circuit court order pertaining to any of the provisions
4 included in the final protective order shall supersede those provisions in the final
5 protective order.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 October 1, 2009.
