- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE
- 17 STUDENT MEMBER OF THE HARFORD COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION HAS THE
- 18 SAME RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES AS AN APPOINTED MEMBER.
- 19 (B) (1) UNLESS INVITED TO ATTEND BY THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF A
