A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County – Alcoholic Beverages – Salaries of Inspectors**

3 **PG 307-09**

4 FOR the purpose of providing that alcoholic beverages inspectors of the Board of
5 License Commissioners of Prince George's County shall receive a certain annual
6 salary; making certain technical changes; and generally relating to alcoholic
7 beverages inspectors in Prince George's County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

21 15-109.

22 (r) (1) This subsection applies only in Prince George's County.

1 (6) (i) The County Council shall pay for all expenses of the Board
2 of License Commissioners upon the submission of an annual budget.

3 (ii) In that budget, the salary of the members of the Board, the
4 salary of the attorney for the Board, and any additional compensation for legal fees for
5 the attorney for the Board, shall be approved as hereinbefore set forth.

6 (iii) [All] **EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (IV) OF**
7 **THIS PARAGRAPH, ALL** other expenses, including, but not restricted to, [the
8 compensation of the inspectors,] the salary of the administrator as limited herein,
9 compensation of other personnel, who shall be qualified and employed under the
10 county merit system, **AND** printing, supplies, and office space, shall be at the
11 discretion of the County Council.

12 **(IV) EACH INSPECTOR SHALL RECEIVE AN ANNUAL SALARY**
13 **OF \$10,900.**

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 July 1, 2009.
