2 **Prince George's County – Alcoholic Beverages – Salaries of Inspectors**

4 FOR the purpose of providing that alcoholic beverages inspectors of the Board of
5 License Commissioners of Prince George's County ~~shall~~ may receive a certain
6 annual salary; making certain technical changes; and generally relating to
7 alcoholic beverages inspectors in Prince George's County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

2 (r) (1) This subsection applies only in Prince George’s County.

3 (6) (i) The County Council shall pay for all expenses of the Board
4 of License Commissioners upon the submission of an annual budget.

5 (ii) In that budget, the salary of the members of the Board, the
6 salary of the attorney for the Board, and any additional compensation for legal fees for
7 the attorney for the Board, shall be approved as hereinbefore set forth.

8 (iii) [All] **EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (IV) OF**
9 **THIS PARAGRAPH, ALL** other expenses, including, but not restricted to, [the
10 compensation of the inspectors,] the salary of the administrator as limited herein,
11 compensation of other personnel, who shall be qualified and employed under the
12 county merit system, **AND** printing, supplies, and office space, shall be at the
13 discretion of the County Council.

14 (IV) **EACH INSPECTOR ~~SHALL~~ MAY RECEIVE AN ANNUAL**
15 **SALARY OF \$10,900.**

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
17 July 1, 2009.
