SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That: (a) This section applies to any individual who: **(1)** on or after February 1, 2000, was enrolled in the Employees' Pension System under Title 23 of the State Personnel and Pensions Article as an employee of the City of Annapolis: (2)on or after July 1, 2003, began working as a contractual employee for the City of Annapolis while participating in the Employees' Pension System; (3)on or after July 1, 2008, became a permanent employee of the City of Annapolis; and while a member of the Employees' Pension System as a contractual employee of the City of Annapolis had:

It shall remain effective for a period of 6 months and, at the end of December 31, 2009, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
